Allan Ramsay announced the Prior Authorization pilot study, to reduce the burden of prior authorization in primary care, will close on May $1^{\rm st}$ 2016. A presentation reporting the results of this study will be presented to the Board sometime in early summer.

Cornelius Hogan brought up two points he found interesting from <u>Becker's Hospital Review</u>: Since 2010, 71 hospitals have gone out of business. Also, if you average the state per capita cost for non-profit hospitals in 2014, there are 30 states whose costs are higher than Vermont's.

New Business

Kate Jones, Financial Director, GMCB, presented the seven proposed amendments to existing Certificate of Need (CON) contracts.

The Board voted (5-0) to execute a contract amendment with Array Architects, Feeley & Driscoll, Baker Newman Noyes, LLC, Initiate Government Solutions, LLC, ECRI Institute, KJWW Engineering Consultants, P.C., New England Medical Design, Inc, for continuing work on the CON projects, and that each contract amendment not exceed \$60,000.
