Subject: 2019 VMNG and BCBSVT QHP Program Quality Measures Results

Dear GMCB and Healthcare Advocate Policy Teams,

Please find enclosed two attachments that are OneCare VT's 2019 Quality Measures results scorecards for the Vermont Medicaid Next Generation Program and the BCBSVT QHP Program.

For the Vermont Medicaid Next Generation program, OneCare received a score of 95%, earning 19 of the 20 available points. OneCare received four bonus points for achieving statistically significant improvement in the following measures:

- 30 Day Follow-Up after Discharge from the ED for Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse or Dependence (moving from the 75th to the 90th percentile)
- Developmental Screening in the First 3 Years of Life
- Diabetes Mellitus: Hemoglobin A1c Poor Control (>9%) (moving from the 50th to the 90th percentile)
- Engagement of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse or Dependence Treatment (moving from the 50th to the 75th percentile)

For the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Vermont Qualified Health Plan (BCBS QHP), OneCare received a score of 81%, earning 14.5 of 18 available points. OneCare received two bonus points for achieving statistically significant improvement in the following measures:

- Hypertension: Controlling High Blood Pressure
- Diabetes Mellitus: Hemoglobin A1c Poor Control (>9%)

As you are aware, the Quality Scores for the Medicare Vermont All Payer ACO Model for the 2019 performance year will be released by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services later this year.

These results have been posted on our website. Additionally, in coordination with our partners we plan to release the results to the press later today.

Please let us know if you have any additional questions and we look forward to presenting the results to the full Board later this fall when Medicare results for 2019 become publically available.
