These documents detail the personal assets and liabilities for these individuals. While this information is pertinent to the financial strength, this information is highly sensitive and should



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be exempt under from public disclosure under 1 V.S.A. 317 (c) (7). As such, the Applicants ask that these Attachments be maintained as confidential.

Vermont law strongly supports the privacy of this information. For example, in *Trombley v. Bellows Falls Union High School dist. No. 27, 160 Vt. 101 (1993)*, the Vermont Supreme Court held that personal documents, including personal financial information, are subject to exemption under the above statute.
