Financial Update

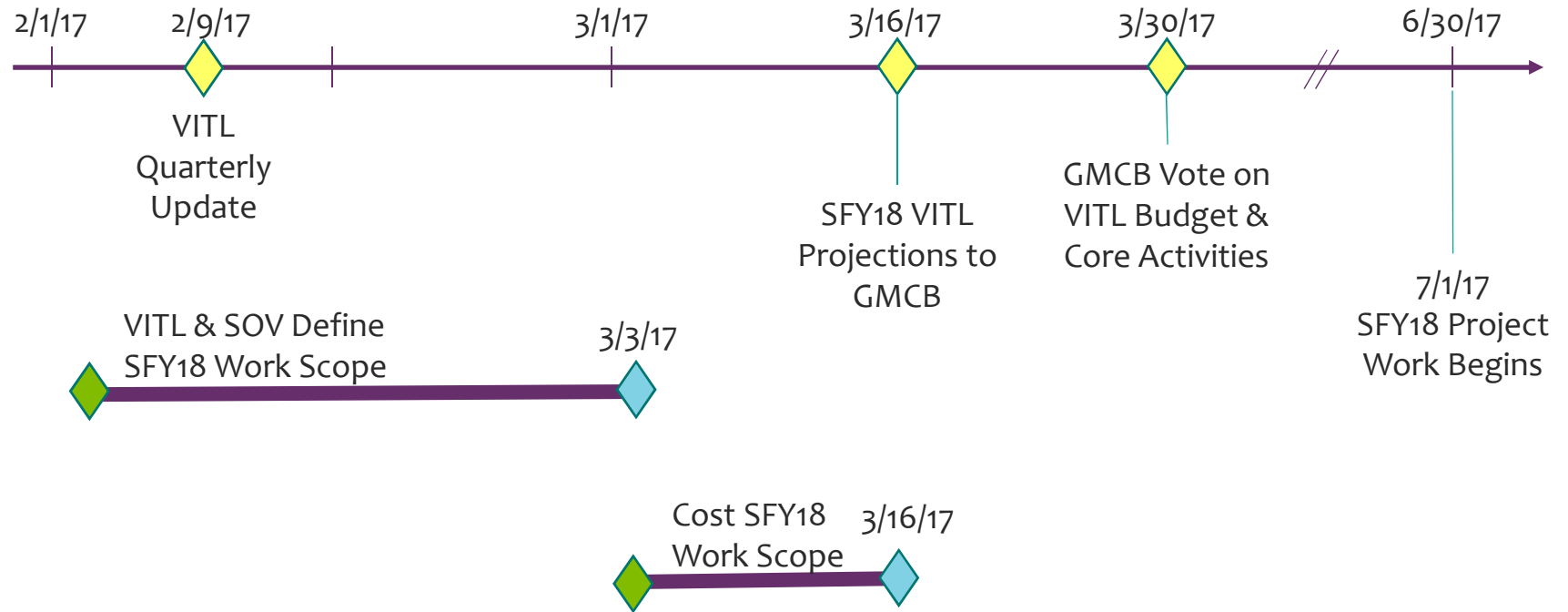
Status of Contracts

- IAPD
 - FY17 contract was awarded in December
 - The contract value is \$1,008K
 - Projects: VITLAccess Onboarding, Interfaces-New, and Data Quality
 - Back-dated to July 2016
 - Began work on VITLAccess and Data Quality projects in July
 - Contract concludes on June 30th
 - Amendment for Phase 2 of Terminology Services is pending
- Negotiated work scope for OCV third year's work, amendment pending
- SIM contract amendment pending
- Negotiations for FY18 work is underway

FY16 Rate Agreement

- Concluded negotiations in December with the SOV on FY16 indirect rate agreement
- Outcome of review: State paid VITL \$363K with \$157K yet to be billed for completed FY16 work
- VITL proceeding with FY16 Annual audit with external auditors, expected to be completed by March 31st

FY17 2nd Quarter Highlights

Ambulatory CCDs from UVM MC

- Care summaries (CCDs) from UVM MC ambulatory practices went live in December
- This is one of the largest data interfaces in the State with over 3,000 new care summaries added each day!
- This should improve the value and use of VITLAccess and greatly increase the amount of clinical data in the Health Data Management Infrastructure
- VITL and UVM MC used an innovative new method to identify the patients who visited an ambulatory provider
- VITL then performed a query against the PRISM system to collect the CCD and load it into the VHIE

OneCare Vermont Projects

- Improving Patient Match Rate
 - Implemented the OpenEMPI product
 - Performed an analysis of patient matching and demonstrated a significant improvement (approximately 20%) in the match rate as compared with the Medicity MPI
- Terminology Services
 - Performed an initial pilot project to map Hemoglobin A1C tests for 5 sites to national codes
 - This improves the use of this lab data for OneCare
- Data Quality Report
 - Delivered a high level data quality report to OneCare for their clients
 - This report gives an overview of the OneCare data but does not show the issues with the data.
 - VITL has an IAPD project to develop interactive dashboard reports which would describe the quality of individual data elements used as clinical quality measures

DAIL Project – Get Home Health Agencies Connected

- With VITLAccess, clinicians within the home health community will have access to the statewide data available in the VHIE for use at point of care.
 - Home health clinicians view other community care team members' data to promote continuity of care across care settings
- With SIM funding, VITL client services team will implement the VITLAccess service with all home health agencies across the state.
- The VITLAccess implementations are accomplished utilizing a phased approach (three phases in total).
- Phases one and two are completed!

Vermont Care Partners Data Quality Project

- Two year data quality project with 16 member designated agencies and specialized service agencies
 - Goal of the project: Capture high quality data in a standard manner at 'the source' organization to improve data quality and to support electronic exchange of data (for required reporting)
 - Completed on December 31, 2016
 - Highly satisfied clients – both VCP and agencies
- Current state interviews
 - Face to face discussions with staff responsible for entering data related to the Monthly Service Report (MSR)
- Workflow assessments
 - Visual write up representing the data collection
- Development of data dictionary of standard data elements
- Data quality recommendations and training
- Positioned to implement recommendations to work toward data quality improvement; complete, accurate and consistent data
