Dear Ms. Jerry

I am writing for a jurisdictional determination. I currently hold an APRN/FNP license in Vermont, 101.0095764 which expires on 3/31/2019. I am planning to start a solo medical practice in Montpelier, with a panel size of 400 patients in total. I am using a hybrid model, in part Direct Primary Care, part concierge billing insurance (not participating in ACO to start with) and seeing Medicaid patients. Total expenses for this operation are anticipated to be <\$115,000 per year.

The services provided will be the same as a traditional primary care office. There is no mobile or fixed CT, PET-CT, MRI or other imagery on-site. The only diagnostic device present in the office is an EKG. We will offer only CLIA-waivered labs - in-house testing will include strep, influenza, urinalysis and similar, common tests.

Could you please ensure that I am in compliance with the waiver which we discussed and do not need a certificate of need?
