In accordance with Title 18, Chapter 221 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, the Green Mountain Care Board (GMCB) has received a Letter of Intent from Valley Vista/OAS LLC in Bradford to convert 14 beds currently licensed for youth to beds licensed for adults by the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent, Division of Licensing and Protection.

However, intervenors may submit a request in writing to the GMCB at the address listed below, on or before May 28, 2019 if they expect to request Interested Party or Amicus Curiae status.

An individual or entity proposing an identical or substantially similar service may submit a competing application. A Letter of Intent to file a competing application must be submitted to the GMCB at the address below no later than May 21, 2019.
