## SECOND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

The Board issues this Second Amended Scheduling Order to change the deadline for submitting written post-hearing arguments from April 26, 2019, to May 3, 2019, as requested by ACTD, LLC d/b/a Green Mountain Surgery Center (GMSC).

- 1. GMSC must submit any additional documents it intends to rely on by April 8, 2019.
- 2. On or before April 8, 2019, GMSC must submit a witness list that identifies the individuals it intends to call as witnesses at the hearing. GMSC must provide a brief description of the nature of the testimony each individual is expected to give. In addition, GMSC must identify each individual it may ask to offer expert testimony at the hearing. For each potential expert witness, GMCB must identify the witness's qualifications (e.g., curriculum vitae(s) or resume(s)), including a list of all publications authored in the previous ten years.
- 3. The Board may pose additional questions to GMSC or require GMSC to submit additional documents prior to the hearing. Any such questions or document requests will include a deadline for GMSC to respond.
- 4. Interested Parties have until April 10, 2019 to identify any witnesses they intend to call at the hearing and to provide the information described in paragraph two above.
- 5. Testimony from Interested Parties will be limited in duration to approximately twenty minutes per Interested Party.
- 6. The Office of the Healthcare Advocate will have approximately twenty minutes to ask questions at the hearing.
- 7. Public comment will be taken at the end of the hearing.
- 8. All testimony will be taken under oath and the hearing will be recorded by a court reporter.

- 9. If GMSC or an Interested Party wishes to file written, post-hearing arguments, it must do so by May 3, 2019.
- 10. GMSC and the Interested Parties are required to copy each other on all correspondence and documents sent to the Board.
