#### **FY17 Deliverables Status**

  - All 9 capable VT Home Health and VNAs pushing data to the VHIE (for a total of 27 interfaces)

  - Completed project to connect to 2 Agencies to receive data from home monitoring devices
- Medicity:
  - Improved VITLAccess performance from 5 seconds to < .5 seconds</li>
  - Capability for organizations to electronically submit patient consent to the VHIE (Required by 4 hospitals including UVM MC)

#### VITLAccess:

- 2,736 subscribers; 28% increase in FY17
- 115% increase in patient data queries (increased from 278,285 to 597,329)
- 56% increase in patient data queries per user
- 56% increase in number of patients who have given consent
- Developed online self implementation application
- 263 instances of Security risk assessment, Meaningful Use & General Health Information Technology (HIT) consulting services were provided to VITL client healthcare organizations.
- Client Satisfaction Surveys (Q1 Q4)
  - o "I trust VITL" weighted average score: 4.17 / 5.0
  - o "I would recommend VITL" weighted average score: 4.00 / 5.0




