## 2. Hospital Financial Assistance During COVID-19

No official changes to the Financial Assistance Policy. However, a letter was sent to our patients indicating that effective April, 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, all self-pay balance and payment plan collection efforts were postponed for 30 days.

b.

As mentioned above, we have sent a letter to our patients postponing all collection efforts for 30 days. In this letter, we reiterated that financial assistance options were available, and encouraged all those facing financial difficulties to contact one of our Customer Service Representatives to discuss how we can assist with their balance.
