Follow up question from 08/26/20 GMCB budget hearing

1. Please provide analysis on why NPR/FPP are not realizing any of the increases in gross revenue. The "Change in charge and net revenue increase" schedule shows that we are expecting \$2,236,943 in additional net revenue from the actual.

Please see the chart below, for both budget 20 and budget 21 we are expecting the same percentage of reimbursement.
