Dear Ms. Jerry,

I am writing to inform you that we would like to rescind the request confidentiality on the LOI and financial information that I submitted to you yesterday Monday September 23, 2019.

The LOI states our intent to submit a CON application for a new medically supervised withdrawal treatment center for individuals with substance use disorders, located in Stowe, Vermont. Silver Pines at Stowe will be a 32-bed facility for individuals who have subacute biomedical, emotional, behavioral, and/or cognitive problems that require 24-hour care by trained addiction, mental health, and medical providers. The LOI contains preliminary information to commence the CON application process and receive preliminary feedback.

We had respectfully request expedited review of this CON application under 18 V.S.A. § 9440(c)(5)(D) in order to get our facility operational in an expeditious manner to meet the urgent needs of people with substance use disorders. I want to reiterate that request please.

We had also respectfully requested confidentiality but after further consideration and my conversation with you today, I formally ask to rescind such request. Confidentiality is no loner requested.
