
PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with Chapter 221 of Title 18 V.S.A., the Green Mountain Care Board (GMCB) has received a Letter of Intent from the Vermont Veterans' Home in Bennington. The project is a security and access control project involving the installation of a comprehensive electronic security system that includes access control, CCTV, door locks, monitoring systems, emergency call boxes and intrusion alarms. Project cost: \$2,623,375.

An individual or entity may request Interested Party or Amicus Curiae status throughout the process up to five (5) business days following the Board's closure of an application. However, intervenors may submit a request in writing to the GMCB at the address listed below, on or before May 5, 2021 if they expect to request Interested Party or Amicus Curiae status.

An individual or entity proposing an identical or substantially similar service may submit a competing application. A Letter of Intent to file a competing application must be submitted to the GMCB at the address below no later than April 30, 2021.
