
PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with Chapter 221 of Title 18 V.S.A., the Green Mountain Care Board (GMCB) has received a Letter of Intent from Feel Like Oh Yeah, LLC to develop a QC Kinetix franchise outpatient clinic for pain management. The applicant represents that the QC system begins by drawing blood from a patient; processing the blood using the QC Kinetix system and returning the blood to the patient's body through an injection to the region of the body requiring treatment. Procedures may rely on the use of plasma, platelet rich plasma, A2M (Alpha 2 Macroglobulin), placental tissue, and bone marrow stem cells administered through musculoskeletal injections.

An individual or entity may request Interested Party or Amicus Curiae status throughout the process up to five (5) business days following the Board's closure of an application. However, intervenors may submit a request in writing to the GMCB at the address listed below, on or before July 15, 2021 if they expect to request Interested Party or Amicus Curiae status.

An individual or entity proposing an identical or substantially similar service may submit a competing application. A Letter of Intent to file a competing application must be submitted to the GMCB at the address below no later than 15 days following public notice of the Certificate of Need Application.
