RE: Questions associated with request for amendment to Certificate of Need Docket No. GMCB-019-19con

In a letter dated August 22, 2022, the Green Mountain Care Board staff asked two clarifying questions about the request to amend the certificate of need (CON) to modernize Southwestern Vermont Medical Center's (SVMC's) emergency department and hospital main entrance (Docket No. GMCB-019-19con). Below are answers to those questions.

1. Confirm that all expenditures for the project made to date and all projected expenditures to complete the project are included in the revised total project cost of \$31,000,000 represented in Table 1 and 2 submitted on August 9, 2022.

The revised total project cost of \$31,000,000 is inclusive of all expenditures to complete the project from beginning to completion, including; all expenditures of the project made to date and future expenditures to complete the project.

2. In Table 3b submitted on August 9, 2022, \$220,000, \$180,000, and \$695,600 is listed for "Salaries Non MD" for years 2022, 2023, and 2024. Explain in detail the specific positions and number of FTEs that are included in the expenditures in each of these three years.

The "Salaries Non MD" figures in Tale 3b submitted on August 9, 2022 mirror those in Table 3b submitted with the original approved CON application. The increase in non-MD salaries in 2022 and 2023 reflect additional staff required to maintain patient safety during construction. These additional staff assist with patient rerouting through the temporary hospital entrance and they transport patients to critical services such as the emergency department, laboratory, imaging, and surgery. These staff have been essential to maintain patient safety and ensure that patients safely flow around the construction site so that construction can proceed expeditiously and unimpeded.

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The increase in non-MD salaries in 2024 reflect the addition of staff required to operate the more expansive emergency department, main entrance, and lobby. Three support personnel will be added to the environmental services and maintenance teams to clean and maintain the larger space. Six clinical and administrative staff will be added to outpatient registration and the emergency department team to reflect enhancements in care processes associated with the new layout. Matching the new facility with appropriate staff and effective processes is essential to leverage the new facility layout to improve care quality, the patient experience, and treatment outcomes.

Thank you considering the amendment to this important project.
