Southwestern Vermont Medical Center (SVMC) requests the Green Mountain Care Board grant an amendment to increase the project budget and extend the timeline for the certificate of need (CON) to modernize SVMC's emergency department and hospital main entrance (Docket No. GMCB-019-19con). Below shows the project journey and the request (highlighted green).

In September 2022, SVMC received an amendment to accommodate adjustments to the design in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, inflation of construction materials and labor and a longer project timeline. Here, SVMC requests another amendment to due to further increases in construction costs and labor challenges that have extended the project timeline. The scale of the change in project cost is a material change to the project per statue thereby evoking a need for an amendment to the CON project. The revised project budget appears in Appendix 1.

The project has not changed in scope. The emergency department is nearly complete, including patient registration, triage, care team documentation space, medication room, and most exam rooms. The main entrance is complete. In March, the new outpatient registration and imaging waiting spaces will begin being used by patients. Remaining spaces achieved through renovation include two trauma bays, the decontamination/hazmat space and connection to the laboratory.

Increasing construction costs and labor challenges have increased the project cost to \$32,900,000 and extended the timetable to August, 2024. These are material changes to the CON (Docket No. GMCB-019-19con). SVMC can financially accommodate the increased project cost and will not request a commensurate commercial rate increase. SVMC looks forward to a response to this request for an amendment to the existing CON.
