

OneCare Vermont Accountable Care Organization, LLC Board of Managers Meeting October 20, 2022 Minutes

A meeting of the Board of Managers of OneCare Vermont Accountable Care Organization, LLC ("OneCare") was held remotely via video and phone conference on October 20, 2022. Public access was also available at the OneCare Offices in Colchester, Vermont.

- <u>Call to Order and Board Announcements</u> Board Chair Anya Rader Wallack called the meeting to order at 4:33 p.m. Greg Daniels, CCPO, announced that there were a few missing Conflict of Interest Forms from the Board and he will follow up individually with those managers.
- II. <u>Welcome Board Managers, Invited Guests, and Members of the Public</u> Chair Wallack welcomed members of the public in attendance and offered the opportunity to introduce themselves.
- III. <u>Consent Agenda Items</u>
 Sara Barry, Chief Operating Officer, announced that the consent agenda items would be held for written vote following the meeting.
- IV. Essex Pediatrics: CPR and Mental Health Integration

Carrie Wulfman, MD, Chief Medical Officer, introduced Steve Hale, MD, and Sue Rogers-Low of Essex Pediatrics to talk about OneCare's Comprehensive Payment Reform Program (CPR) and integrated mental health in their practice. Dr. Hale noted that he is one of six providers and the practice serves an estimated 8,000 patients. Essex Pediatrics uses a fully integrated care model to serve their families. The practice has been trying to integrate more mental health services over the last decade, beginning with funds provided by the Blueprint for a social worker and then a nutritionist for a few hours a week. As their care model evolved, they include services such as therapists, social workers, nutritionist, group sessions around anxiety, home visits, a robust postpartum depression screening among other items. The practice's focus was on solving the problems their patients and families faced, and the model evolved to meet the needs. Dr. Hale recognized that funding from OneCare's CPR program has helped the practice expand these services and currently the two organizations are discussing
