MVP Health Care Non-Standard Plan Changes – Potential Vote

Christine Smith, Professional, Commercial Product Strategy and Design, MVP Laura McAlonen, Professional, Commercial Product Strategy and Design, MVP

Christine Smith reviewed the Qualified Health Plans (QHP) products and the portfolio of the non-standard plans. Christine Smith stated that the Bronze 5 plan is the plan that is highlighted in the presentation, reviewed why this is subject to GMCB review, and the GMCB evaluation criteria. Christine Smith presented the plan design changes including changing the deductible and the out-of-pocket max, which would decrease the premium by approximately 4.07%. Christine Smith stated that this proposal adds value to the Vermont market and that the new plan design would not negatively impact most of the bronze members.

The Board Members asked questions about the impact of raising the deductible and the co-pays for preventative services that do not go toward a deductible.

Board Member Lunge moved to approve the plan design changes to the MVP Health Care Bronze 5 QHP. Board Member Walsh seconded the motion. The Board voted (4-0) to approve the motion.
