2014: Faris Ghawi & Amer Alnajar established their first practice in NY, offering on-demand care 24/7

2016: Developed & Deployed a data-driven, Medicare-focused care delivery model to improve outcomes, reduce waste and costs; Expanded into NJ

2018: Enhanced business model, allowing physician partners to share in cost savings generated through Medicare, forming an ACO

2021-22: Expansion into 9 new markets, including New England
