## **LETTER OF A JURISDICTIONAL DETERMINATION**

To the Green Mountain Care Board of Vermont

Dear Sir Madam,

I am writing to request a jurisdictional determination for the Long Life Care of Vermont LLC, a Home Health Care Agency that will be providing services in Chittenden County first before extending them statewide in the future. Long Life Care of Vermont LLC is a company that will be providing home care services, companionship, activities of daily living, and medication reminders to clients who need them in Chittenden County first. However, as the company continues to grow, we will seek to extend our services statewide. We would like to begin with nonmedical services first to stabilize the company. However, in the next Three to Four years, we will be exploring an opportunity to incorporate medical services into our company and work with financial institutions that can boost the company. If there is any need for medical services with our clients in the beginning, we will partner with other agencies to provide medical services to our clients. We will provide services to clients in their homes, retirement homes, assisted living facilities, or nursing homes whenever necessary. These services may change depending on the needs of the clients; however, they should align with the core services defined by the company, otherwise, we will still work with other agencies to meet the customer's demands.

While serving the communities we love so much, I noticed that there is a growing demand for home care services, activities of daily living, companionship, and medication reminders for many people, including the elderly people and the affected youths in our communities who need help to cope with their daily life activities and manage their health issues. Many of our elderly people in Vermont find themselves alone with nobody who can help to complete daily life activities such as meal preparation, laundry, shopping, grooming, and light cleaning of the house to help them feel at home. Others are not even able to schedule a doctor's appointment, get their medication reminder, or simply do not get someone who can talk or walk with them as their family members do not have time or can be away from them, thus causing more stress and anxiety in their lives. As a result, employees of Long-Life Care of Vermont LLC are committed to providing these activities to the people who need them the most and ensuring that our elderly people and the affected youths in Vermont do not feel isolated in their communities when they need help.
