I, Carl Cameron, MD, Chief Medical Officer, hereby attest, to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, that within the past twelve months MVP Health Plan, Inc. and MVP Health Insurance Company (collectively, "MVP") reviewed the list of medical procedures and medical tests for which MVP requires prior authorization and has eliminated (or is in the process of eliminating) the prior authorization requirements for those procedures and tests for which such a requirement is no longer justified or for which requests are routinely approved with such frequency as to demonstrate that the prior authorization requirement does not promote health care quality or reduce health care spending to a degree sufficient to justify the administrative costs to the plan.
