Medicare Performance Benchmarking Report- FY24 Budget Order



1. OneCare must continue to support an ACO performance benchmarking tool that compares key quality, cost, and utilization metrics to national ACO metrics in accordance with its FY22 Budget Order, its FY23 Budget Order, and further defined by this Order.[...]
 - e. The 2024 benchmarking report must additionally include (i) statistical significance analysis and (ii) risk of all cohorts for each year.
 - f. An updated benchmarking report must be submitted to the Board by March 31, 2024.

Extension Request



On March 15th, OneCare Vermont submitted requests to:

1) “Extend the initial 2024 report submission date from March 31, 2024 to April 30, 2024 in order for OneCare’s vendor to receive data from CMS, analyze, revise reporting, and conduct appropriate external data quality assurance processes to allow for this report, including beneficiary risk levels, to become a public document.”

2) “Delay submitting statistical significance testing to the September report to allow a continuation of the conversation between the GMCB staff, OneCare and its vendor regarding technical specifications to meet the statistical significance requirement of the GMCB.”

Move that the GMCB approve OneCare Vermont's request(s):

- 1) Regarding Condition 1(f): extend the deadline for OneCare to submit its updated benchmarking report from March 31, 2024 to April 30, 2024.*
- 2) Regarding Condition 1(e)(i): extend the deadline for OneCare to submit its statistical significance analysis from March 31, 2024 to the deadline set for the second semi-annual benchmarking report, as stated in the ACO Reporting Manual.*
