Notification Regarding Exception to VHCURES Regulation H-2008-01: Suspension of the Requirement to Submit Eligibility and Claim Data to the Vermont Health Care Uniform Reporting and Evaluation System (VHCURES) for Vermont Residents Enrolled in Medicare Supplement Insurance Policies April 28, 2015

The purpose of this notice is to clarify the [Green Mountain Care Board](#)'s (GMCB) reporting requirements for the Vermont Health Care Uniform Reporting and Evaluation System (VHCURES). This mandated reporting system was created under V.S.A. 18 §9410 and transferred by legislative mandate to GMCB in 2013. This notification replaces the prior notification addressing Medicare Supplement reporting dated April 10, 2010 titled, "Notification Regarding VHCURES Regulation H-2008-01 Exempting Medicare Supplement Insurers from Requirement to Submit Claims Data." Following that notification, Medicare Supplement insurers were required to submit eligibility records only for Vermont members.

GMCB has suspended the requirement in Regulation H-2008-01 Sections 4 and 5 that stipulates the filing of eligibility and claims data by Medicare Supplement insurers until such time that GMCB may reverse the suspension of the requirement. If and when the suspension that grants an exception to the Regulation is reversed, the state will provide advance notification to affected insurers regarding the reporting requirements.
